Features from the 2013 International Metal Decorators Association Annual Conference

This year, the theme of our conference was Metal Packaging: A Brand's Billboard. If a billboard is facing the wrong way on a street, drivers and pedestrians miss it. If a magazine ad appears in a magazine that readers don't reader, they miss that ad. If millions are spent on an incredible television ad, but viewers are watching something else, they miss it. But, anyone who picks up a product in metal packaging sees the brand name and the incredible graphics that have either been printed on a flat sheet or in the round. Metal packaging is the brand's billboard that no one misses.

Besides offering a first class package, constant technological improvement has allowed metal packaging to surf at the top of marketing waves. Metal decorating creates pop and zing that attract attention and inspire strong brand recognition much the same way that the magnetic north pole points attracts all compass needles to point north.

Our presentations provided information on current metal decorating trends that would otherwise entail presentations requiring planning, organization, travel, and wasted idle time. We found the best of the best and organized them into two days of tight programming and networking that provided remarkable take home value.

There were five sessions held over two full days. On Wednesday, there was a morning session followed by lunch. On Wednesday afternoon, we conducted two breakout sessions, one for two piece decorating and another for flat sheet decorating. On Thursday morning we had a full morning session followed by lunch. The afternoon was split into tutorials that were designed to offer the basics and refresher presentations on essentials of the products and services in the metal decorating industry.

On Wednesday afternoon, after the sessions, vendors in our industry displayed their products and services in a two hour table top exhibition. This highly valuable opportunity allowed attendees to get questions answered, collect brochures, meet vendors, see samples and pursue concepts from many vendors in one place and in one period of time.
