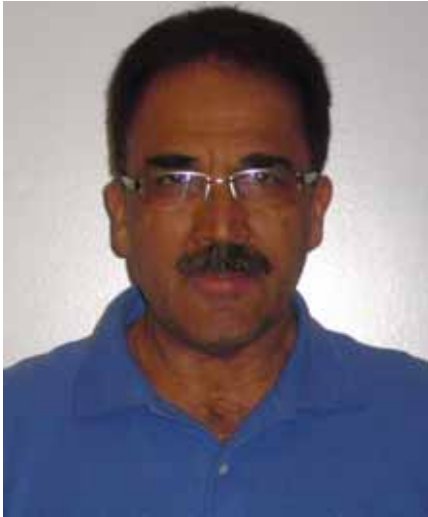
2012 DECORATORS OF THE YEAR
